Alan and I are doing what we can to use the propaganda work around one case to deal with Marion for many reasons, not the least of which is the surety of our own return there when this trial comes to some resolution for us. It's been good to see some real progress in getting national & international attention focused on the prison. The climate would seem to be improving. We recently sent a letter to Jan about our thoughts on calling for new Congressional hearings (we think it's time). Perhaps you might ask her about this.

The reason I'm writing is fairly mundane - we're in the position now of answering inquiries from people about the film "Through the Wire" and we'd like to have some brochures from the CEML about Marion to send out in an all-purpose press packet as well as to have available for our defense committee's work.
