3. 8 Month Proposal for Control Unit Campaign:

Objective: to create national consciousness re the Control Unit prison at Florence and Control Units generally, and to continue the process of building an activist network to abolish Control Unit prisons.

Activities:

A. Coordinated nationwide (and international?) spring demonstrations to take place on the weekend of May 2-3, 1992 to protest the construction of the CU prison at Florence. Additionally, people could focus on CU prisons in their region.

B. Proposed activities between now and then:

each area would sponsor at least one educational activity between now and the next 8 months.

each area would produce one flyer about Florence and the CU in their area.

each area would organize some amount of systematic petitioning.

the next Walkin' Steel (#3) will be produced by CEML. People in other areas could contribute articles about their planned activities and WS could be used to organize for the Spring activities in particular.

Walkin' Steel #4 could include reports on activities in all areas.

4. Tentative commitments from people in each of the areas. Who could possibly do what?
5. Walkin' Steel: how could it be used more effectively? How have the listing of contacts worked out? Should we send list of people on our mailing list in your areas?
6. Other geographical areas where people may be interested in working on the campaign?
