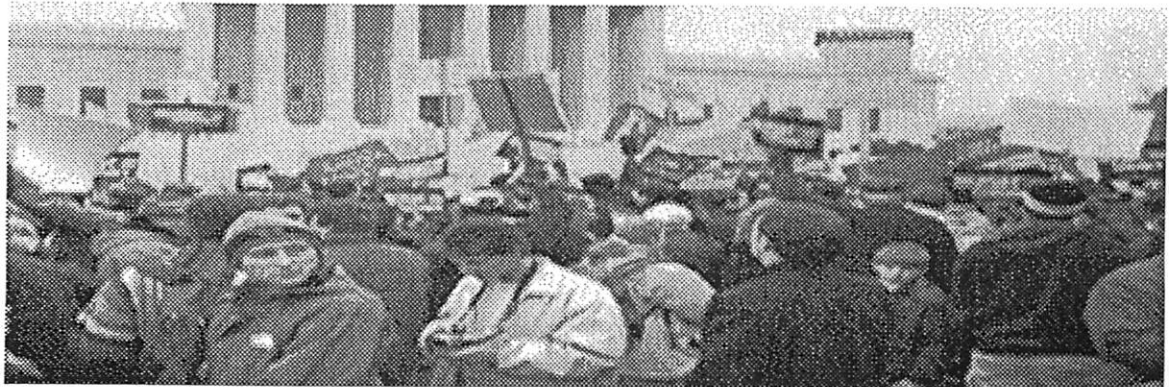

**FEBRUARY 11-12, 2002
WASHINGTON, DC**



The National Mobilization Against State Repression is a two-day action against government repression that will take place in Washington DC on February 11-12, 2002. Organized by the Mobilization for the Protection of Civil Liberties (MPCL), these two days of action are aimed at drawing national attention to the growing concern over the eroding civil liberties resulting from policies instituted by the United States government both prior to and after the September 11, 2001 attacks. Some of these concerns relate to:

- ~The USA PATRIOT Act
- ~Military Tribunals
- ~Political Grand Juries
- ~Congressional Subcommittee on Ecoterrorism
- ~Increased FBI/NSA/Secret Service Surveillance and Harassment
- ~Extreme growth of the prison industrial complex
- ~State and federal anti-terrorism legislation
- ~and more!
