ON SEPTEMBER 2, 1945, HO CHI MINH ISSUED VIET NAM'S DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE FROM FRANCE. IN AUGUST OF THAT YEAR A GENERAL INSURRECTION SWEEPED VIETNAM. THIS RISING FOLLOWED DECADES OF ~~FRENCH COLONIALIZATION AND THE BRUTUAL~~ REPRESSIVE FRENCH COLONIZATION, ^{UP} WHICH ^{in the countryside} CULMINATED IN TWO YEARS OF MASS STARVATION ~~IN~~ TWO MILLION VIETNAMESE PEOPLE STARVED TO DEATH BETWEEN 1943 AND 1945.

THE DAY HO CHI MINH DECLARED INDEPENDENCE, SEPT. 2, 1945, THE EMPEROR BAO DAI, WHO HAD COOPERATED WITH THE FRENCH ABDICATED AND FLED FROM HANOI. BUT IN 1950, THE FRENCH SET UP A NEW ARTIFICIAL COUNTRY, MAKING SAIGON THE CAPITAL AND ^{setting up} ~~PLACING~~ BAO DAI AS EMPEROR AND NGO DINH DIEM AS HIS PRIME MINISTER.

^{In 1954,} AFTER NINE YEARS OF DETERMINED STRUGGLE, THE VIETNAMESE PEOPLE WITH THE LEADERSHIP OF HO CHI MINH AND THE INDOCHINESE COMMUNIST PARTY DEFEATED THE FRENCH IN THE DECISIVE BATTLE OF DIEN BIEN PHU.

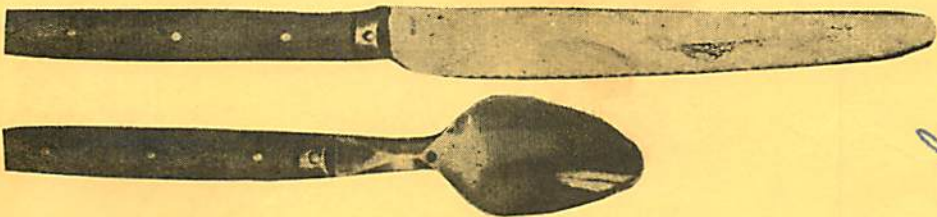

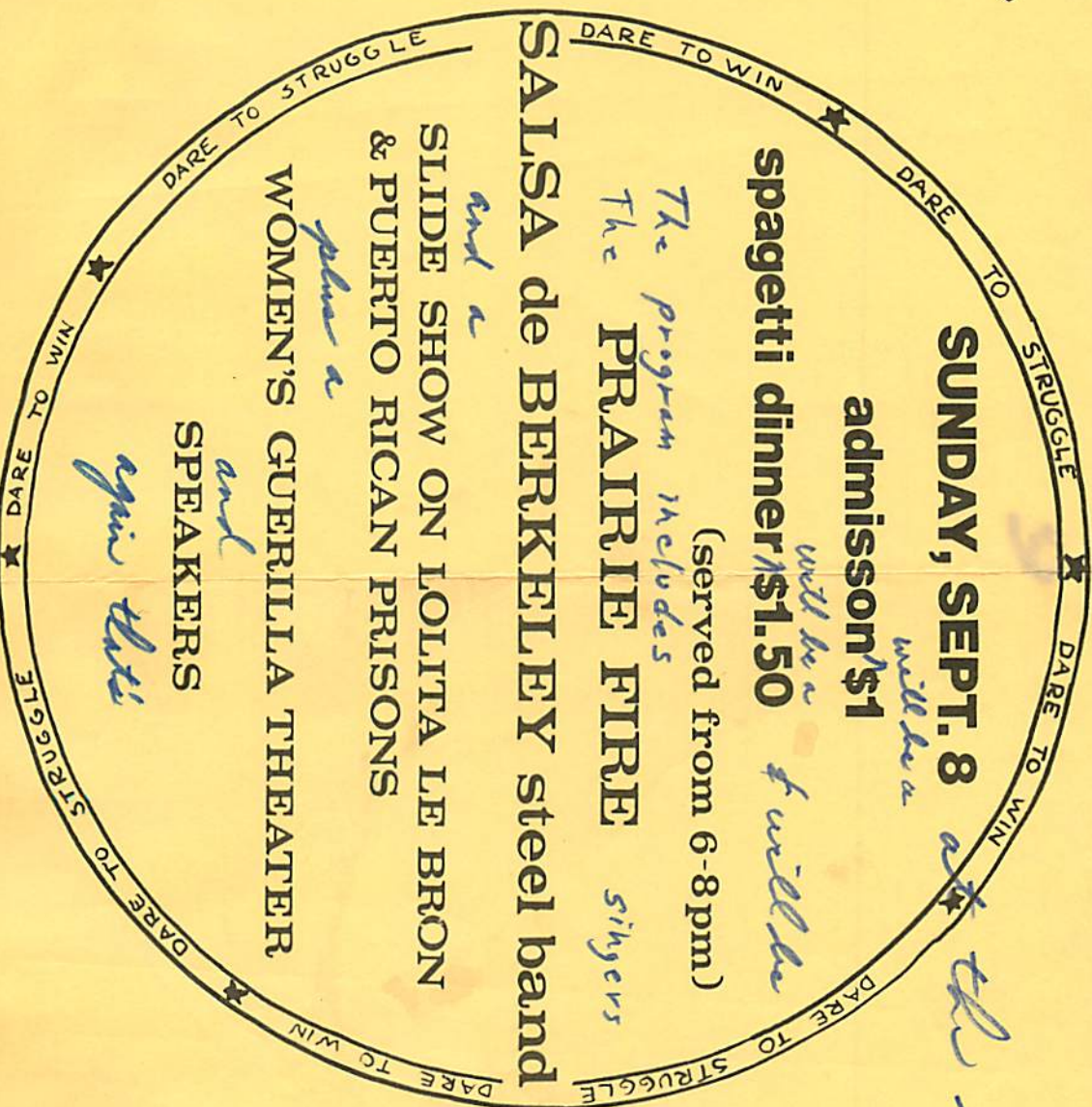

We can no longer tolerate laziness, people who are so drunk that if the police was to vamp, they would not be in any condition to deal with it, or so full of cocaine they have become so paranoid that they spend their time talking shit or pistol-whipping everyone in sight. We cannot tolerate the “veterans of the struggle” who seem to feel that if their blueprint is not on your ideas and actions then those ideas and actions are incorrect. It is up to us to organize the people. If you don't hit it, it won't fall. We don't need memorial services or long drawn out speeches praising Comrade George. What we need is support units waging a battle against the oppressor. And that support must come from action and not merely words. Only social practice can be the criterion of truth. We must remember that “a revolution is not a dinner party, or writing an essay, or painting a picture, or doing embroidery; it cannot be so refined, so leisurely and gentle, so temperate, kind, courteous, restrained and magnanimous. On September 10 Portugal will officially recognize the independence of Guinea-Bissau, the former colony of "Portuguese" Guinea. The historic decision was reached in an eight-point agreement signed on August 26 at the People's Palace in Algiers

The Portugal-PAIGC accord declared a formal cease-fire in
Guinea-Bissau, ending 11 years of guerrilla war.

The major compromise in the agreement is the provision for a referendum to be held on the future of the Cape Verde Islands—ten small islands in the Atlantic Ocean, 400 miles northwest of Bissau. Earlier talks in London and Algiers had broken down over this point. The PAIGC considers the islands to be an integral part of their nation of Guinea-Bissau. But Portugal had refused to relinquish the strategically-located islands which are used by NATO forces and South African airlines. The decision to hold a referendum cleared the way for a final settlement. Portugal affirmed the right of the people of Cape Verde to self-determination and independence, and the PAIGC is expected to win any vote held on the islands.

The agreement also says that Guinea-Bissau and Portugal will "establish and develop relations of active cooperation, notably in the economic, financial and cultural and technical fields, on a basis of independence, mutual respect and equality."

The agreement is the culmination of 18 years of political agitation, 11 years of armed struggle and a year of intensive international diplomacy. Last September 24 the PAIGC held a

National Assembly in liberated territory where 120 elected delegates issued a declaration of independence, proclaiming the



Republic of Guinea-Bissau. The Portuguese government called it a "publicity stunt" and the U.S. State Department said Guinea-Bissau did not meet the requirements of a nation. But by November 1973 the United Nations had recognized the new West African nation as an independent,

sovereign state and condemned Portugal's "illegal occupation" of the country. Only seven countries, including the United States, voted against the U.N. resolution. Within months over 60 Third World and socialist countries recognized Guinea-Bissau. Now the number exceeds 107.

On August 12 of this year the U.N. Security Council voted unanimously to recommend that Guinea-Bissau be granted full membership in the United Nations. A favorable General Assembly vote is certain this month.

The independence movement started in 1956 when Amilcar Cabral, an agricultural engineer educated in Lisbon, met secretly in Bissau with six others to form the PAIGC. In Portugal, Cabral had joined with other African students to form the Center for African Studies.

Cabral became a Marxist, influenced strongly by the Cuban and Vietnamese revolutions, but he stressed that a political and military strategy had to be developed in "Portuguese" Guinea based on the specific history and conditions in that

country. He prepared careful, detailed studies of economic and social classes in the territory, analyzing what tribes and strata of the population would be most prepared to join the fight for independence. From

At first the PAIGC organized demonstrations in the cities aimed at ending the Portuguese practice of forced labor, excessive taxation and floggings. But on August 3, 1959 Portuguese troops massacred some 50 striking dock workers, and the secret police (~~PIDE~~) arrived in the country. The party went underground and prepared for an armed confrontation.

In 1963 the PAIGC declared war against the Portuguese and began the guerrilla struggle. But Cabral, insisting that politics always direct the military tactics, continued to emphasize mobilization of the African population and opened a school in Conakry, Guinea, to train organizers. A

the PAIGC immediately built schools in liberated territory and established a democratic system of village councils. Rice production was increased, the first medical clinics were opened in remote jungle areas and people's stores were set up

The PAIGC forces rapidly took control of the countryside, destroying isolated Portuguese military posts and ambushing river traffic. In the last years of the war, the 33,000 Portuguese troops and several thousand African mercenaries

were confined to the cities and major forts and relied on air power to wage the war. Planes, often supplied by West Germany and the United States indirectly through NATO, dropped napalm and fragmentation bombs on PAIGC villages.

A turning point came early in 1973 when the PAIGC acquired hand-held SAM-7 missiles and began to shoot down Portuguese planes (see ~~IB #2~~ interview with PAIGC leader Joao Silva).

Cabral was assassinated in January 1973 by Portuguese agents. The movement was temporarily stunned. But the PAIGC had by then become a well-disciplined, stable organization with an extensive popular base and a large number of experienced leaders and trained cadre. Aristides Pereira became secretary-general of the PAIGC and Luis Cabral, Amilcar's brother, was elected president of Guinea-Bissau. A few months later the guerrillas had launched what was to be their final sustained offensive.

André Cabral, spoke in Harlem 28
where he received an honorary
degree from Lincoln Univ. - and had
this to say -

Several years before his death, Cabral told a rally in the Oio forest: "And what about after our victory? What will happen afterward? We are not going to have people who steal others' labor then. Because it is not only whites who steal others' labor; blacks do it, too. But we won't have any more of that here. Everybody is going to work and enjoy the product of his labor. Now you've got to tell me if you really mean to get to work."

~~A French observer wrote~~, "A great many hands were raised in agreement."
