C This demonstration is a protest against the Bird Air company. Bird Air is now ferrying arms and ammunition to the tottering US-backed Lon Nol dictatorship in Cambodia.

A Bird Air is operating under a "civilian" contract to the US Air Force. US military activity in Cambodia is in direct violation of the 1973 Paris Peace Agreement, which prohibits any form of foreign military activity. (~~Article 20, Section B~~).

C Bird Air is just one example of the "dirty tricks" used by the US government to violate the Peace Agreement and also to evade Congressional restrictions on US war-making in Indochina. Bird Air is a symbol of the continuing US government war policy.

N Now, as the Cambodian people are pushing towards the overthrow of the dictator installed by the CIA, it is important that the voice of the anti-war movement be heard clearly and loudly.

C Let's tell Bird and Ford: together with the Cambodian people, we will defeat your war plans.

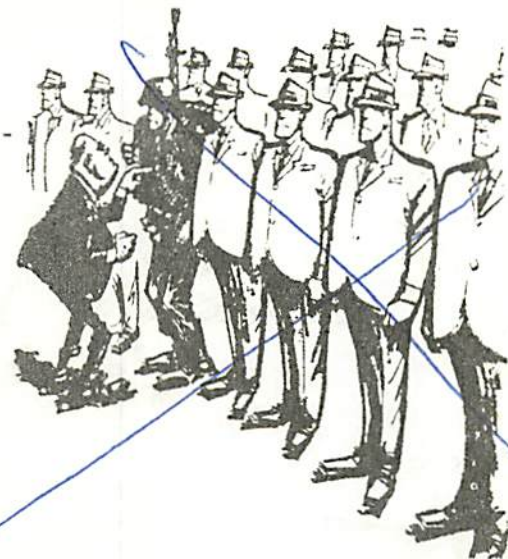

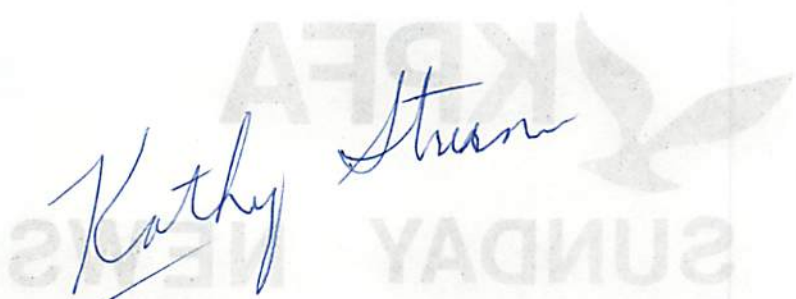
