In Thanksgiving week, continuing repression against Native Americans. AIM leader Russell Means was sentenced to 30 days in prison after conviction on an assault charge in Pierre South Dakota. The assault charge stemmed from an incident in which Means and others had gone to a country club to protest discrimination and to charge the country club with illegal presence on Indian land. The judge refused to allow <sup>attorney</sup> William Kunstler to defend Means. The 30 day sentence against Means was suspended while he faces trial on another charge in Souix Falls. Earlier this week, 4 Native Americans were indicted for the murder of 2 FBI agents last June 26th.

These November days mark the anniversary of the days in 1969 when the Indians of all Tribes claimed Alcatraz island in the San Francisco Bay. The Alcatraz occupation, which lasted many months, was finally ended by authorities, but the action served as a very important spark to a new rising tide of Native American militancy and organization. Alcatraz was like a beaconlight, signalling the rise of a new resistance.....

Just as white mercenaries and the US Cavalry once engaged in massive genocide against Native American peoples, so too ~~was~~<sup>has</sup> the new US imperialism launched genocidal onslaughts against peoples around the world. But the movements for independence and national liberation have grown much stronger. This week in Angola the difficult struggle there has become ~~the~~<sup>a</sup> focus of world attention. Kissinger has attacked the Soviet Union and Cuba for aid to the <sup>Popular Movement, the</sup> MPLA. The MPLA ~~has emerged as~~<sup>is</sup> the <sup>only</sup> legitimate representative of the Angolan people, with UNITA and the FNLA clearly serving as nothing more than instruments of ~~XX~~ South Africa~~X~~ and imperialism. In an important shift, the Peoples ~~XXXX~~ Republic of <sup>is</sup> China ~~XXXXXX~~ withdrawing advisors ~~to the FNLA~~ and cancelled <sup>all</sup> financial aid to the FNLA. A radio broadcast from the FNLA said the Chinese showed more interest in political ideology than military tactics. While it is difficult to assess the military situation in Angola, reports indicate that the Popular Movement for the Liberation of Angola~~X~~ is making gains. US aid continues to the ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ FNLA and the battle could be long and hard. Meanwhile US mercenaries are being recruited to fight in Angola//////////t///
